

# Susquehanna County Library Musical Instrument Borrowing Guidelines

## Electric Guitar

To borrow an instrument, you need to be a resident of Susquehanna County with a Susquehanna County Library card in good standing (i.e. outstanding fines/charges less than \$10). Youth under the age of 18 must have their parent's permission to borrow an instrument. Please ask staff and they will assist you.

There is a limit of one instrument per borrower's card at a time. The loan period is 14 days. If no one has requested that instrument, you may renew for an additional 14 days. Only 1 renewal is permitted per check out.

If instruments are kept past the date they are due, there will be a \$2.00 overdue charge per day.

Instruments can be borrowed from any library location (Forest City, Hallstead, Montrose or Susquehanna), but must be picked up and returned to the Circulation Desk at the loaning location.

You will not be charged for broken guitar strings. Please notify the staff person when you return the guitar so it may be fixed for the next borrower.

There are books, DVDs, etc. in the libraries' collections that can help you learn to play the instrument. The list is included in the case.

As with other library materials borrowed, you are responsible for instruments borrowed on your card and for any charges on items that are overdue, lost or damaged.
