- CDs
- DVDs

The following items **cannot** be accepted:

- **any items in poor condition** (torn, dirty, mildewed)
- **any items with missing covers**
- **Reader's Digest condensed anything**
- **Videos**
- **Encyclopedias** older than 2005 *except* The Encyclopaedia Britannica (11th, 12th and 13th editions)
- **Records**
